

SPRING MASS ARRANGEMENT



MATERIALS

Oblong container
Wet floral foam
Plastic frogs and Oasis fix for bottom of container to secure foam

Tulips (no depending on the size of container image has around 12)

Twigs – suggestions
Pussy willow- dogwood.-cherry blossom
Branches with buds

Grass- phormium – midelino cane to loop

Stones or moss or something to cover the top of foam

1. Place plastic frog/s into bottom of container using oasis fix
2. Secure your wet foam into the container leaving space between the foam and the top of container..
3. Insert taller branches of blossom at the back in a line formation.
4. Insert tulips in a mass formation in front of the blossom lower in height
5. Insert a row pussy willow(or sub) into foam in front of tulips in a pleasing pattern to provide interest. Place short stems of blossom in between willow to create harmony
6. Loop into the arrangement grass or similar to provide movement and rhythm.
7. Finish the arrangement by covering the top of visible foam with pebbles.

Tips

- Tulips continue to grow and move towards the light in wet medium.
- To ensure your Tulips remain straight wrap bunch tightly in newspaper and place into the water the evening before arranging.
- Think Texture, rough branches smooth tulips and pebbles
- Proportion- the quantity of materials one component to another
- Scale of plant material in relation to container correct in height.
